



What Will I Learn?

You'll gain the knowledge and skills you need for a successful law enforcement career. You'll be challenged to function as a member of a team through team-building exercises, and you'll test your skills in real-world scenarios at the Treasure Coast Public Safety Training Complex, one of the nation's top law enforcement training facilities.

The final semester of the Academy Track will include the Law Enforcement Basic Recruit Academy. Participants must complete the entry process prior to entering the Academy. Upon successful completion of the Academy, you'll be required to pass the State of Florida Certification Examination. Credit will be articulated from the Law Enforcement Basic Recruit Academy* to college credit.



Why Choose the Academy Track?

This two-year program provides you with the opportunity to obtain an Associate in Science Degree in Criminal Justice Technology and complete the Law Enforcement Basic Recruit Academy at the same time. Upon completion, you will be eligible for certification as a law enforcement professional in the State of Florida.

This selective admissions program provides highly trained, disciplined, and educated recruits. Graduates are well prepared for the workforce and have a head start on career advancement.

What Are the Program

Requirements?

- Minimum of 18 years of age prior to the beginning of the first semester
- High school graduate or equivalent
- No felony or misdemeanor conviction involving false statement or perjury as an adult
- No falsification of any entrance documents
- Placement Testing
- Completion of Criminal Justice Institute Program Informational Sheet
- Completion of Academic Program Questionnaire
- Submission of documentation desired to note accomplishments or to explain events in your life
- Submission of Agency Sponsorship form, if applicable
- Maintenance of a minimum 2.5 GPA for each semester in order to continue in the program.
 - Failure to maintain a 2.5 GPA
 - for one semester will result in probation
 - for two consecutive semesters will result in suspension
 - for three semesters during the program will result in dismissal
