You could serve the public as a law enforcement officer, corrections officer or specialized state or federal agent.

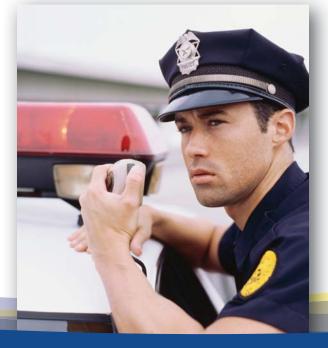
You will be a respected professional in a career field that will always be needed. Employment opportunities in criminal justice are projected to increase by about 10 percent by 2018.
