

Treasure Coast Public Safety Training Complex *presents* Neck Restraint Instructor Certification Course

March 5-7, 2012

This three day intensive course provides instructors with the techniques and knowledge to teach law enforcement personnel various neck restraints including the vascular neck restraint. Day one will feature classroom instruction and day two and three practical physical defensive tactical training.

Students will learn the legal aspects specifically geared to "Use of Force," relevant case studies such as the "Canada Study" and various physical applications of neck restraints to be applied as a professional law enforcement operator.

This advanced course is an instructor level class certifying the participant to instruct personnel within the law enforcement community. Students will be required to make presentations, complete "Use of Force Reports" and participate in mock testimony exercises. Students will also have to demonstrate physical proficiency and pass a written exam.
