



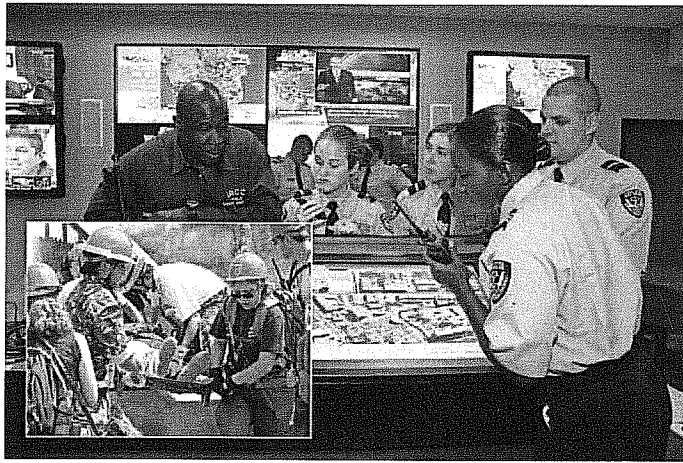

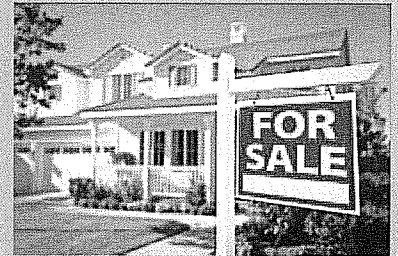
continue their education by enrolling in IRSC's Bachelor of Science in Public Administration with a concentration in Emergency Planning and Management,

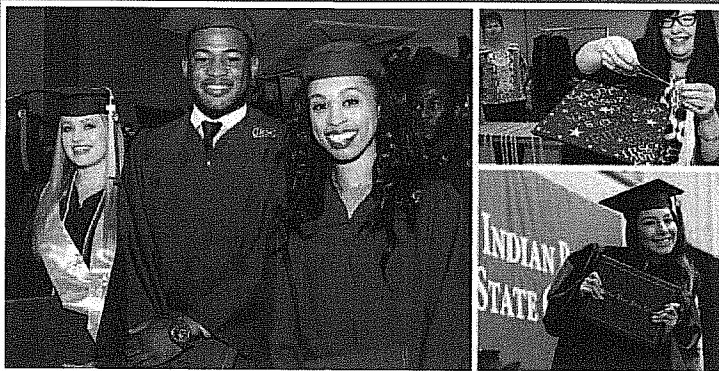
