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# Application Process

## Minimum Qualifications:

- 18 years of age or older
- High school graduate or equivalent
- Complete fingerprinting and background check
- Preference given for successfully completing an EMT or Paramedic program, or NREMT or NRPM certification exam.
- Not have been convicted of a misdemeanor relating to the certification or to perjury or false statements, or a felony or a crime punishable by imprisonment of 1 year or more (Florida Statute 633.412)
- Pass a thorough medical and hearing examination, including drug screen Ability
- to participate in vigorous physical activities without restrictions
- Possess a valid Florida Driver's License
- Nonuse of tobacco products for one year prior to employment

## Application Steps:

All steps must be successfully completed on time in order for consideration.

Step 1: Preliminary Application: Students must turn in a completed preliminary application. Please note that the preliminary application deadline might close prior to the original scheduled date due to the number of applicants. Please check the schedule on [tccpublicsafetytraining.com](http://tccpublicsafetytraining.com) prior to submitting your preliminary application.

Step 2: Attend the Mandatory Orientation: Students are required to attend the mandatory orientation located at 4600 Kirby Loop Rd, Fort Pierce FL 34983 in the Bailey Auditorium, unless stated otherwise. Each academy's mandatory orientation date is listed on the Academy Schedule.

Step 3: Medical Physical and Hearing Test: Information on these will be provided at your mandatory orientation in Step 2. Both tests are mandatory and will be scheduled for you. Tests will not be rescheduled for any reason if the applicant misses their appointment.

Step 4: Orientation Paperwork Due: All paperwork and required testing must be completed and turned in by 4:00pm on your academy's deadline listed on the

Academy Schedule. Students must turn in all the required paperwork listed with their application. Applications with missing/incomplete information will not be accepted.

Step 5: National Fire Selection Inventory (NFSI): Students are required to pass the National Fire Selection Inventory with a score of at least 70%. *(Not required if you were in the 9<sup>th</sup> grade in Florida after 2003-2004 or if you have a college degree.)* Additional information and testing dates will be provided during the mandatory orientation mentioned in Step 2.

Step 6: Physical Agility Test (PAT): Students must pass the PAT test within the acceptable completion time. Each academy will have an assigned Practice PAT and PAT that is listed on the Academy Schedule. Additional information will be provided during the mandatory orientation mentioned in Step 2.

The Fire Science Track Program is eligible for Federal Financial Aid.

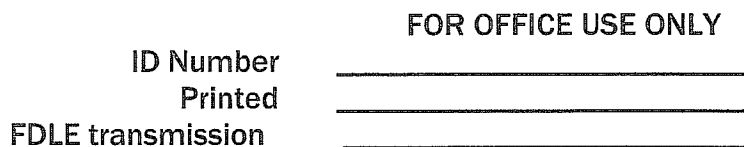
Even though you may be receiving Federal Financial Aid during any previous term of attendance, once you enter the Fire Academy, your Federal Financial Aid may be stopped.

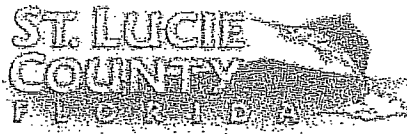
