# Application Process

## Minimum Qualifications:

- 18 years of age or older
- High school graduate or equivalent
- Preference given for successfully completing an accredited EMT or Paramedic program and pass the National certification exam
- Not have been convicted of a misdemeanor relating to the certification or to perjury or false statements, or a felony or a crime punishable by imprisonment of 1 year or more (Florida Statute 633.412)
- Pass a thorough medical and hearing examination
- Ability to participate in vigorous physical activities without restrictions
- Possess a valid Florida Driver's License
- Nonuse of tobacco products for one year prior to employment

## Application Steps:

All steps must be successfully completed on time in order for consideration.

**Step 1: Preliminary Application:** Students must turn in a completed preliminary application and copy of their EMT/Paramedic National Registry certification together during the preliminary application deadline. **Please note that the preliminary application deadline might close prior to the original scheduled date due to a number of applicants.** Please check the schedule on [tcpublicsafetytraining.com](http://tcpublicsafetytraining.com) prior to submitting your preliminary application.

**Step 2: Attend the Mandatory Orientation:** Students are required to attend the mandatory orientation located at 4600 Kirby Loop Rd, Fort Pierce FL 34983 in the Bailey Auditorium, unless stated otherwise. Each academy's mandatory orientation date is listed on the Academy Schedule.

**Step 3: Medical Physical and Hearing Test:** Information on these will be provided at your mandatory orientation in Step 2. Both tests are mandatory and will be scheduled for you. Tests will not be rescheduled for any reason if the applicant misses their appointment.

**Step 4: National Fire Selection Inventory (NFSI):** Students are required to pass the National Fire Selection Inventory with a score of at least 70%. Additional

information and testing dates will be provided during your mandatory orientation in Step 2.

**Step 5: Physical Agility Test (PAT):** Students must pass the PAT test within the acceptable completion time. Each academy will have an assigned Practice PAT and PAT that is listed on the Academy Schedule. Additional information will be provided during your mandatory orientation in Step 2.

**Step 6: Orientation Paperwork Due:** All paperwork and required testing must be completed and turned in by 4:00pm on your academies deadline listed on the Academy Schedule. Students must turn in paperwork listed in order on the orientation application packet check list.

# **Financial Aid and Scholarships**

## **Financial Aid:**

Please be aware the Fire Academy (Fire Fighting – Basic Recruit) is NOT eligible for Federal Financial Aid (Pell Grant, FSEOG, Subsidized Stafford Loan, Un-Subsidized Stafford Loan, and Parent Loan for Undergraduate Students PLUS).

Even though you may be receiving Federal Financial Aid during any previous term of attendance, once you enter the Fire Academy, your Federal Financial Aid may be stopped.

You are encouraged to seek other funding for this program if needed, such as the Workforce Innovations Opportunity Act (WIOA) program. Information on this program is available at any Florida One-Stop Center. Also students who qualify for Florida Bright Futures may receive funding through that program.
